# **BUSINESS LAW SCHOLARSHIPS**

**The Business Law Section (BLS) is excited to announce the opening of its 2016 scholarship program.**

This year the BLS is offering three scholarships to early career lawyers for research papers in the field of business law. Each scholarship comes with a \$5000 prize, and the winner may have the opportunity to present the winning paper to a gathering of eminent senior lawyers from the relevant field.

## **Scholarships**

**GAIRE BLUNT SCHOLARSHIP** – For papers in the field of competition law. Commemorating Gaire Blunt, former Partner at Allen Allen & Hemsley (now Allens) this scholarship recognises his contributions as part of the vanguard of those who were to shape the form, regulation and administration of competition law in Australia.

**FORSYTH POSE SCHOLARSHIP** – For papers in the field of taxation law. This scholarship recognises the contributions of Neil Forsyth QC and Kevin Pose, formerly both leading members of the BLS' Taxation Committee with a commitment to developing and mentoring the careers of many young lawyers.

**SANTOW SCHOLARSHIP** – For papers in the field of corporations law. This scholarship commemorates The Hon Kim Santow AO, formerly Justice of the NSW Supreme Court, Chancellor of the University of Sydney, and leading corporations law practitioner at Freehills (now Herbert Smith Freehills).

## **Eligibility**

The scholarships are aimed at persons at a junior stage of their career in Australia, whether it be as a research student, practising lawyer, academic or member of the public service or corporate sector. Applicants should have no more than four years professional experience in the legal field of the chosen scholarship.

**To apply for the scholarship lawyers will need to submit an unpublished paper of no more than 10,000 words on a topic of relevance to the chosen scholarship field, (including footnotes, appendices and tables), by the 31 July 2016.**
